THE TECH FUTURES STRAND WITHIN CAMBRIDGE TECH WEEK

Building on the success of its inaugural year at Cambridge Tech Week 2024, the Tech Futures initiative is set for significant expansion in 2025.

Designed to support students sixth forms, skills bootcamps, colleges, and universities within the most unequal city in the UK (as defined by the Centre for Cities Report 220628 State of the City Report Committee Final.pdf), this dynamic programme offers underrepresented young people the chance to truly level up with opportunities that would otherwise never be open to them.

CAMBRIDGE **WIRELESS (CW)**

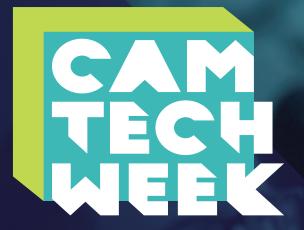
